The quiet teammate

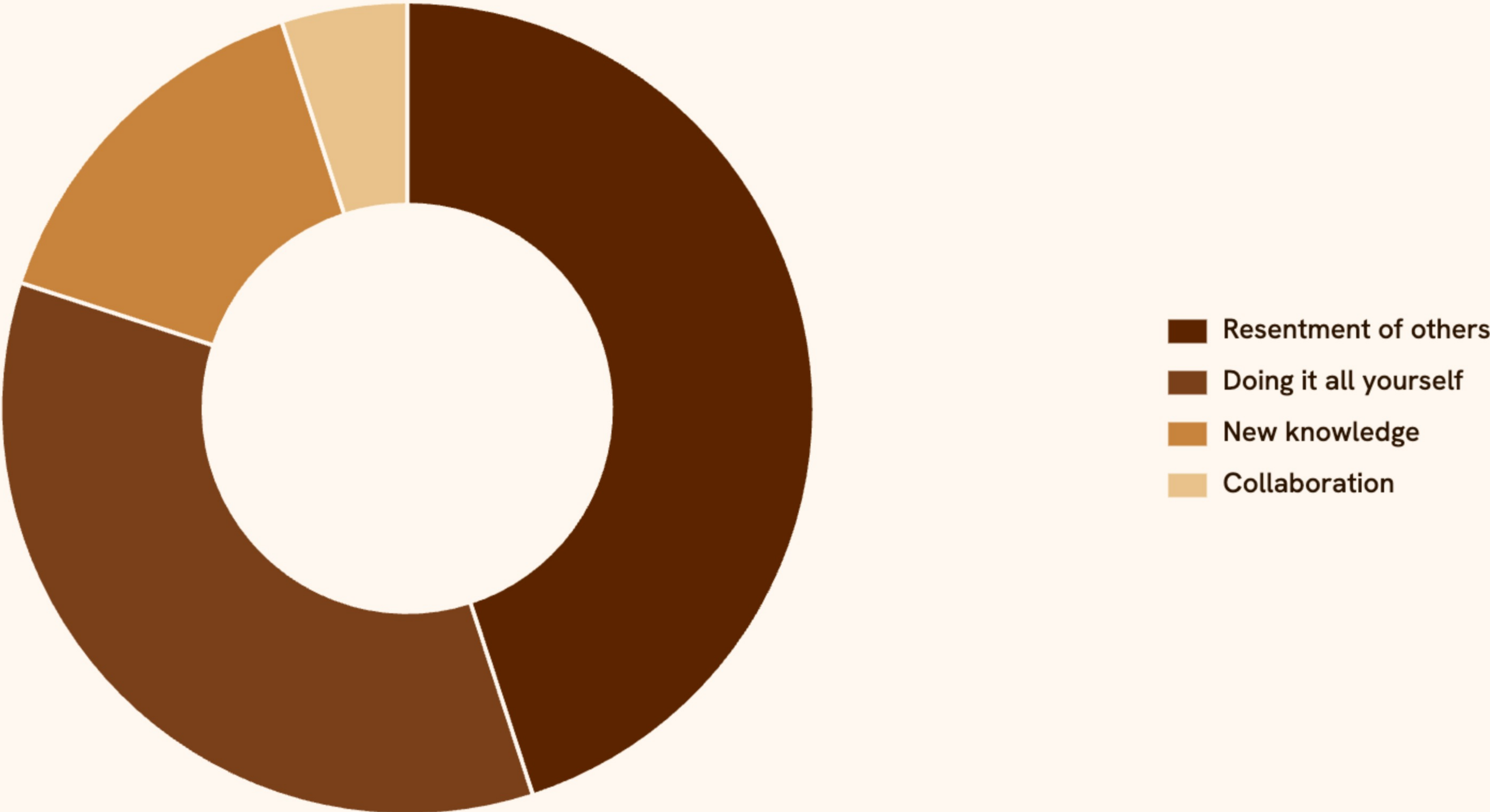

The shared grade

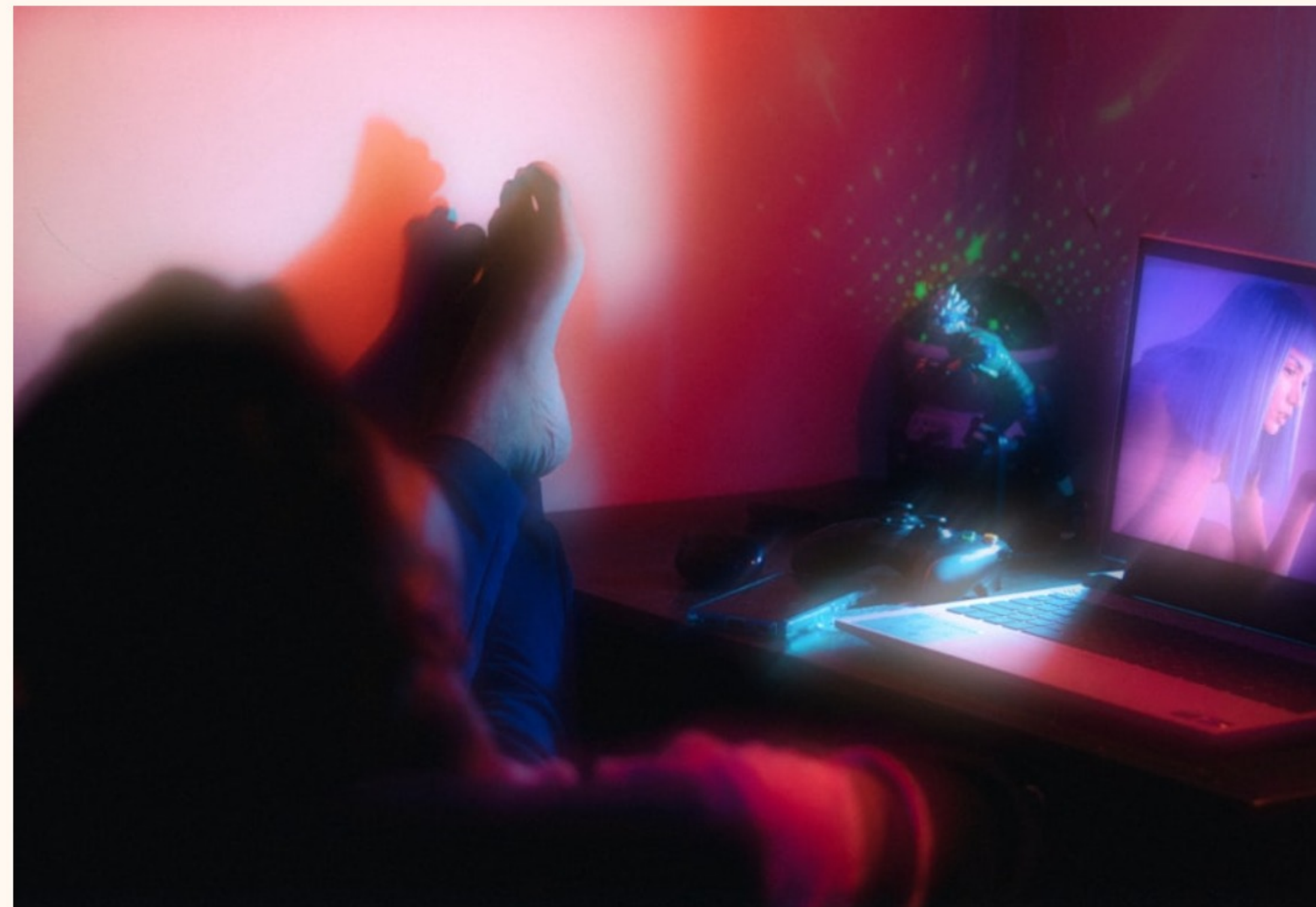
