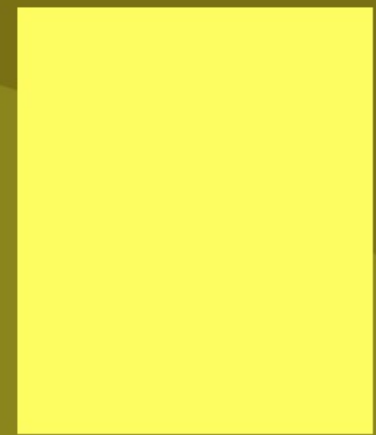
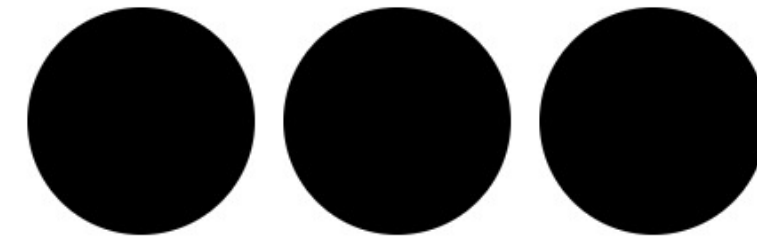

01 The Hardest Step

Starting from scratch, facing a blank page, is where most decks truly stall. You have the idea, but not the first slide—what to put on it, how to lay it out—and the time quietly slips away.

02 Templates Aren't Enough

Most tools give you only a skeleton. Writing, layout, imagery, designing each page—it's all still on you. Templates solve the shape, but they never solve the content for you.

Direct Control

Aligned by nature. The instant you move an element, smart guide lines quietly appear, snapping it neatly onto the grid and its neighbors. No squinting at pixels—everything falls into place on its own, keeping every page in effortless order.

Type Freely

Fine-tune in place

Font · Size

Switch fonts, scale sizes up or down—titles and body each find their place, hierarchy clear at a glance.

Lists

Toggle ordered and unordered in one click, points laid out clearly, logic never scattered.

Color · Align

Pull colors from the theme palette, align left, center or right at will—layout fully in your hands.

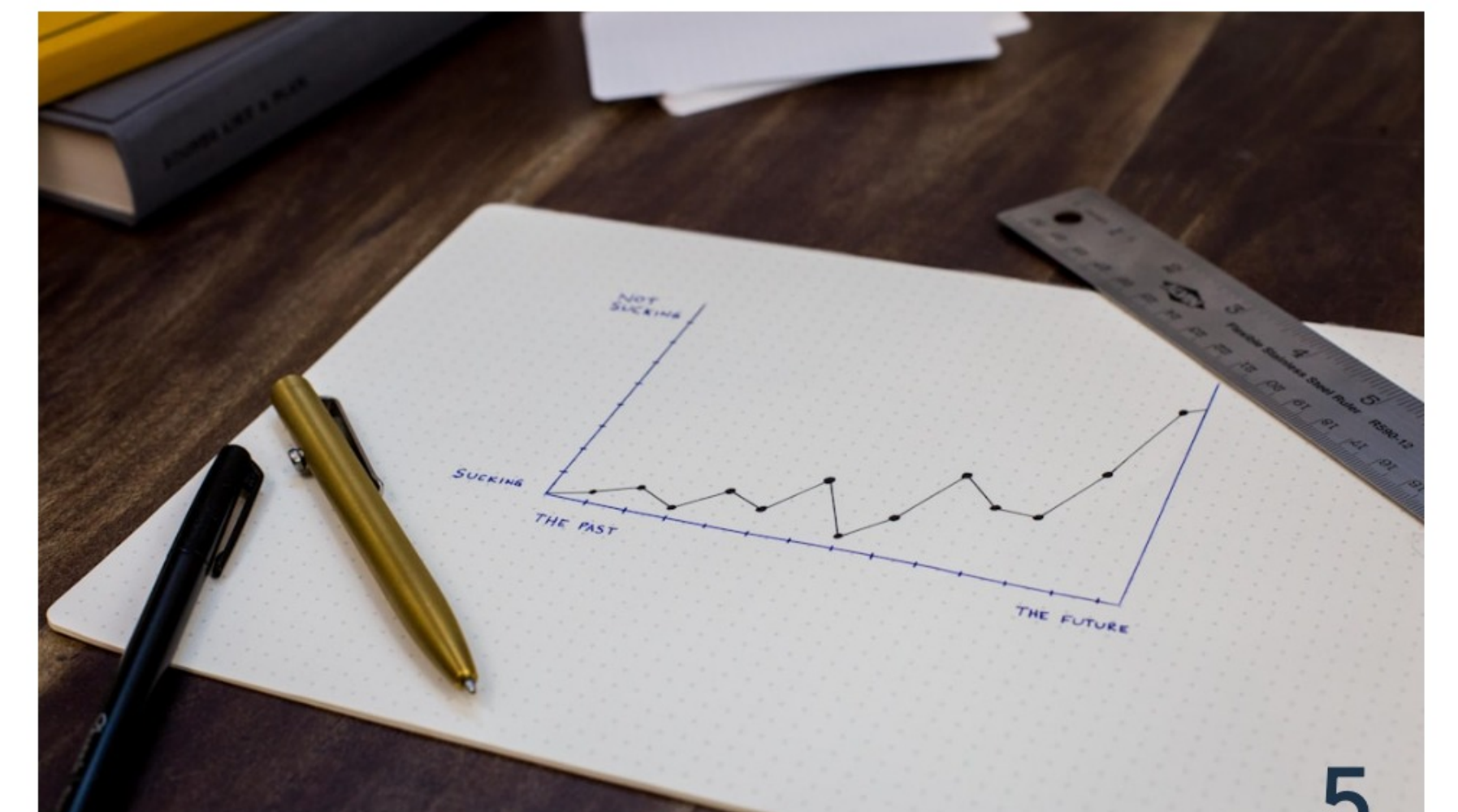
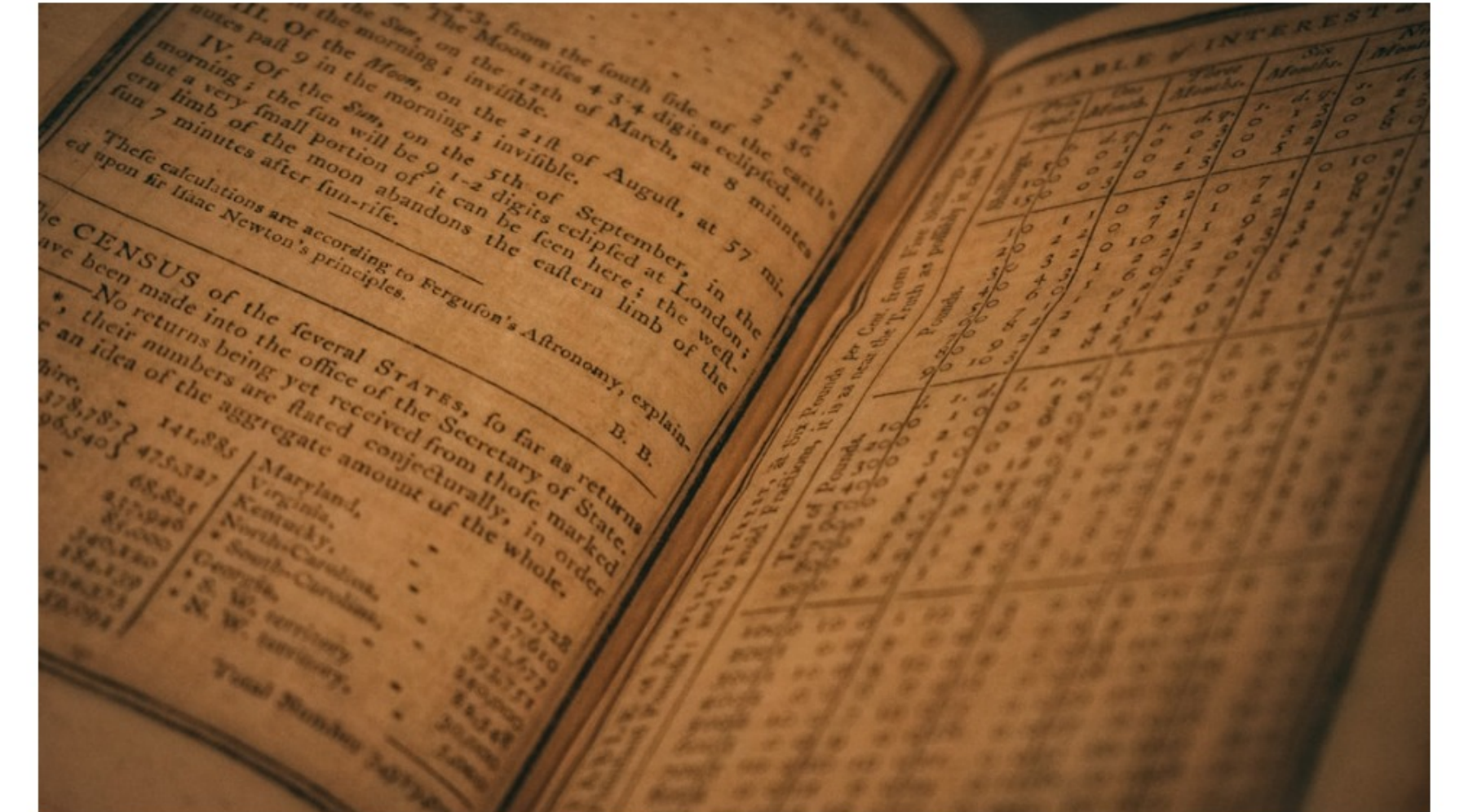
Line Spacing

Adjust line spacing so density feels just right, reading stays comfortable.



Grounded, Not Fabricated ●●●

Real citations: when data is needed, Ocuport cites real, verifiable sources instead of inventing an impressive-looking number. Always current: it favors recent public material so evidence fits today's context. Traceable sources: every external figure can be expanded to view its origin—control stays with you. No filler: when reliable evidence is missing, it prefers words over forcing a fake number. Honesty matters more than polish.

Fonts & Color

Always fitting. Content resizes itself to the layout—text and images land right inside the frame, never overflowing, never cramped. The example below shows the ideal state: title, body and image each in place, whitespace even, margins clean and crisp. No manual scaling—every page looks carefully typeset.

clear hierarchy.



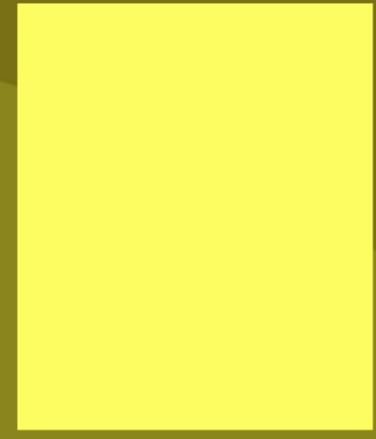

Keep Building

Insert on demand. Halfway through, you suddenly want another page? Just say what you need, and a fully designed new slide drops precisely into the middle of the sequence, without breaking the flow.
